Update

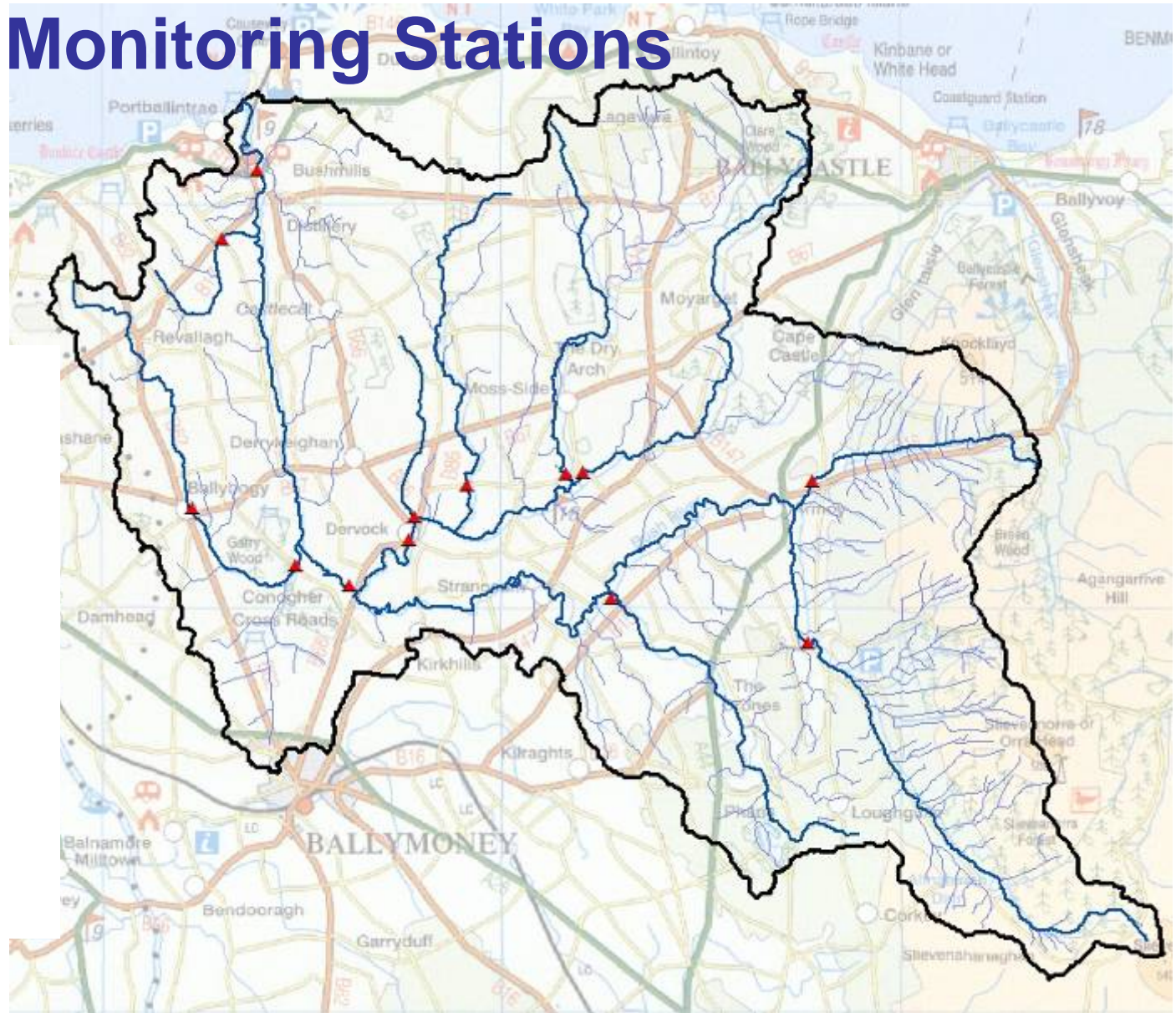
- All relevant parties who wish to participate to complete PAIRS form and return to Helen Nutt.

A number of forms relevant to the CSG area have been returned more available at meeting.

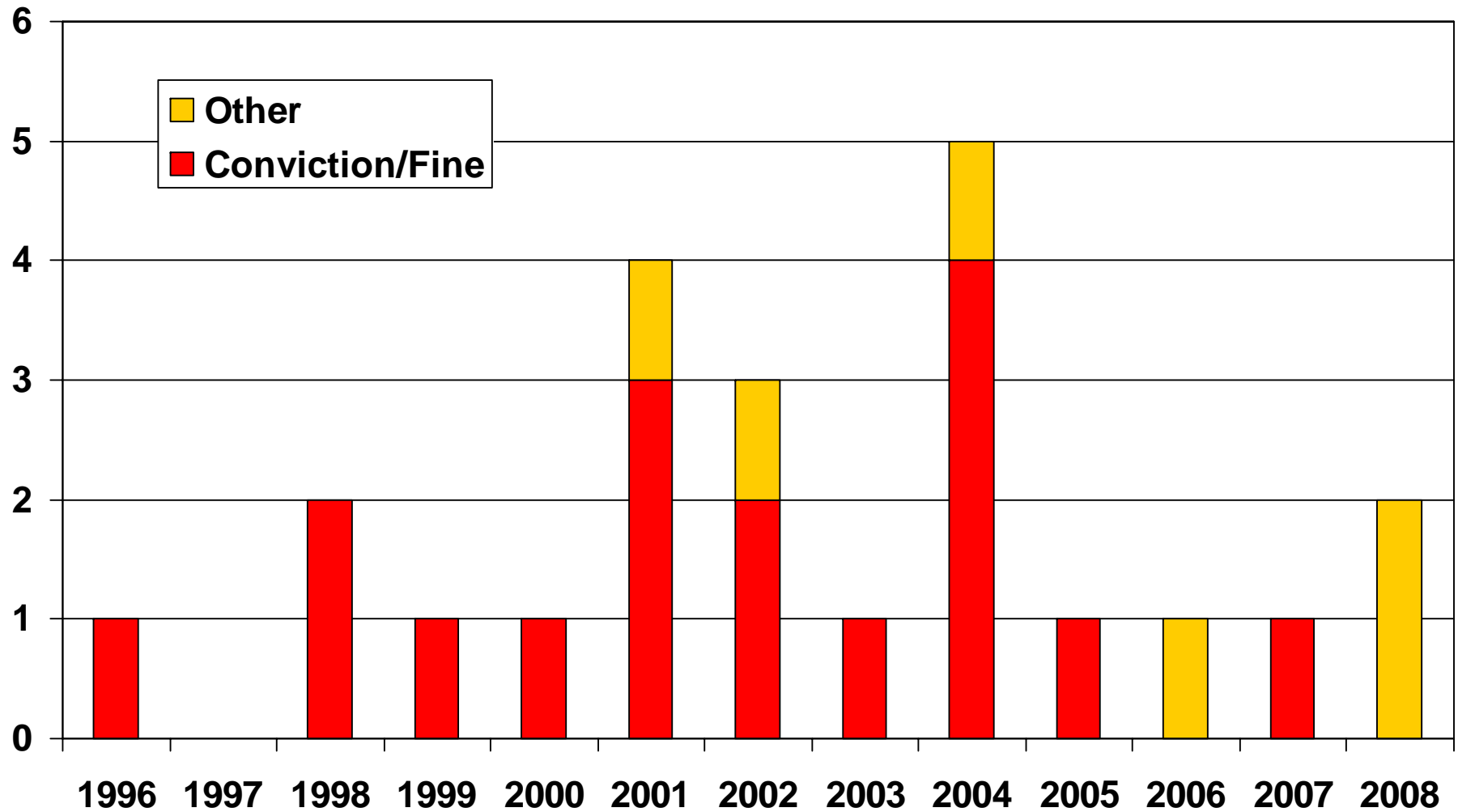
River Bush Monitoring Stations

13 monitoring stations

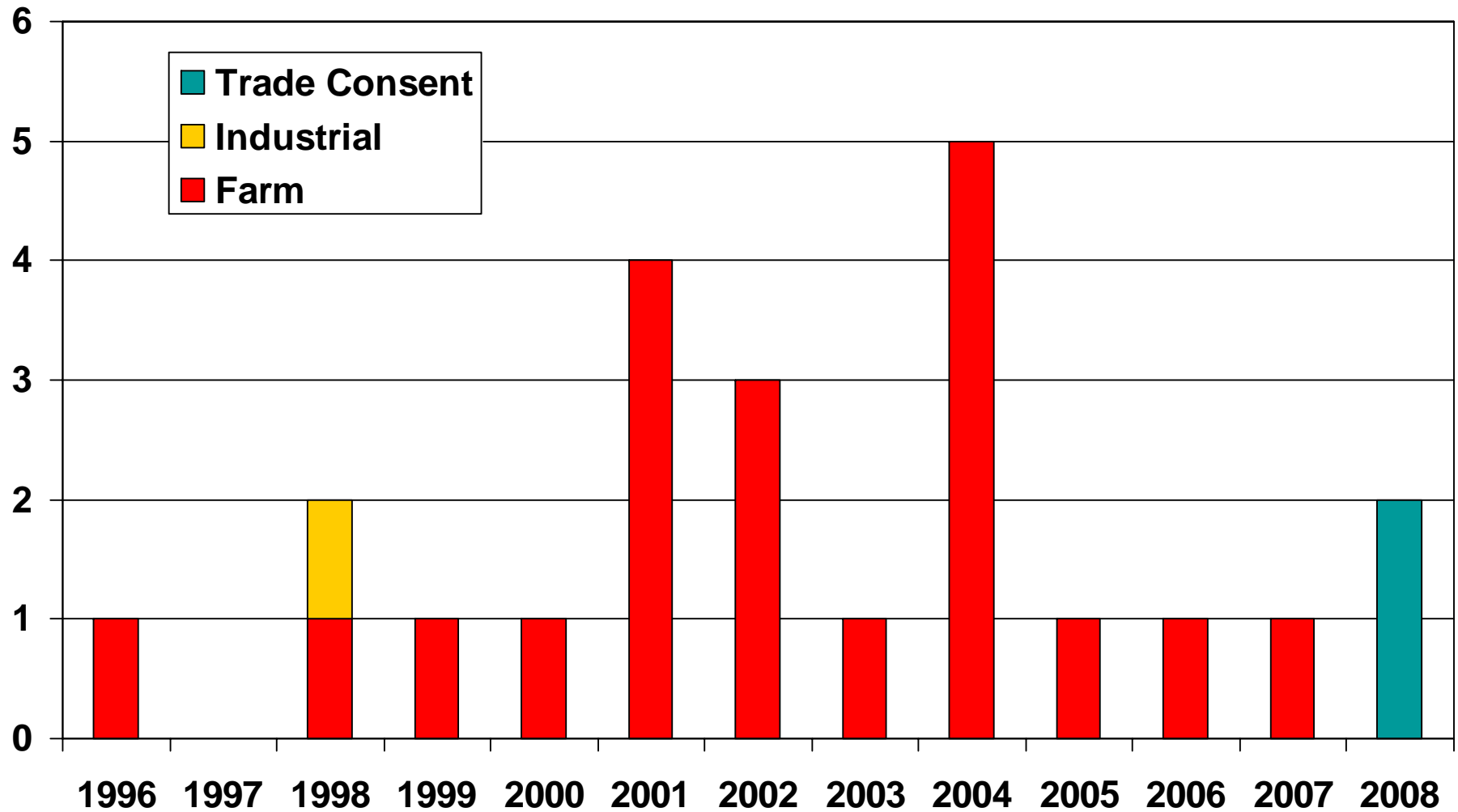
- 11 sites monitored for chemistry
