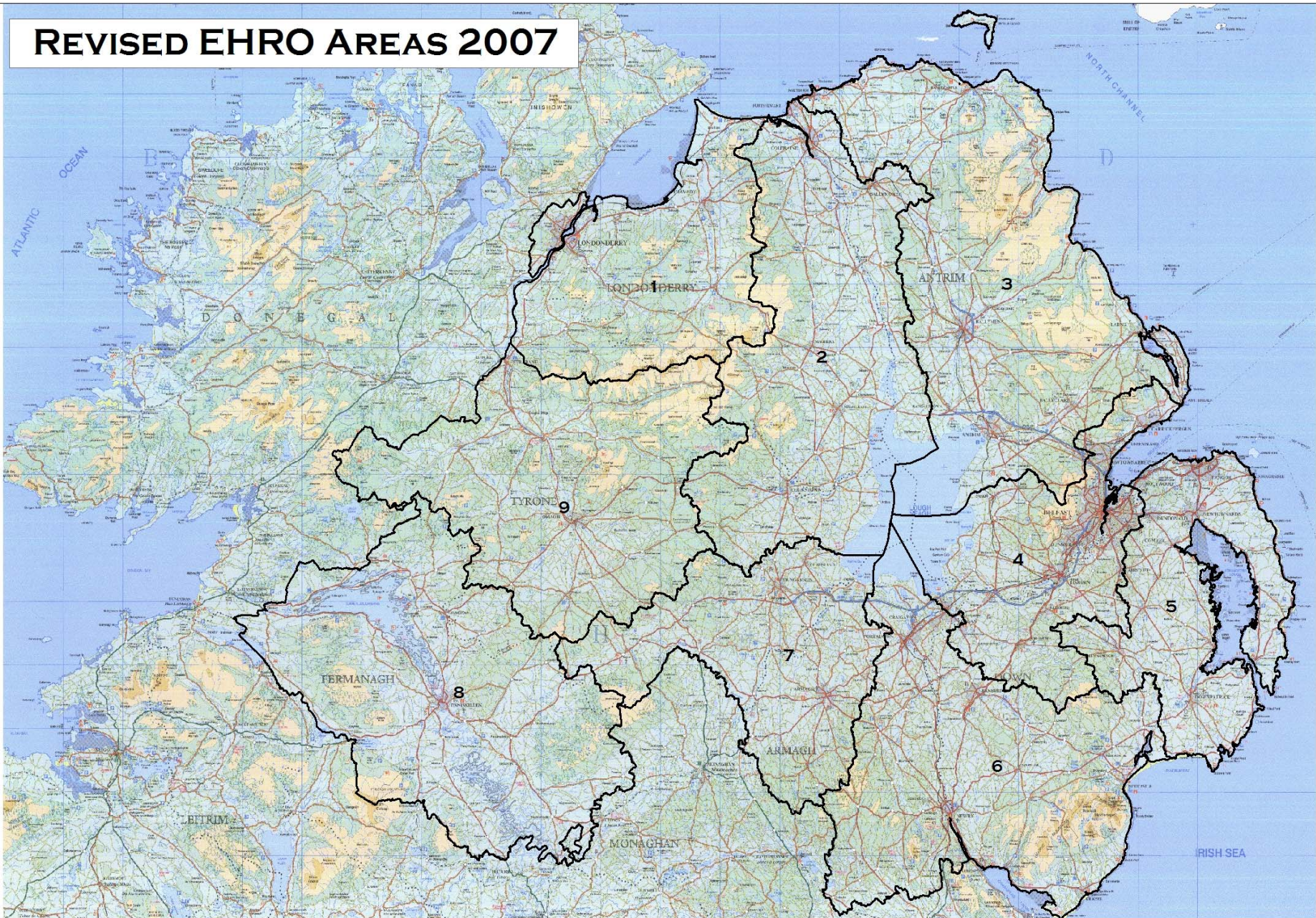

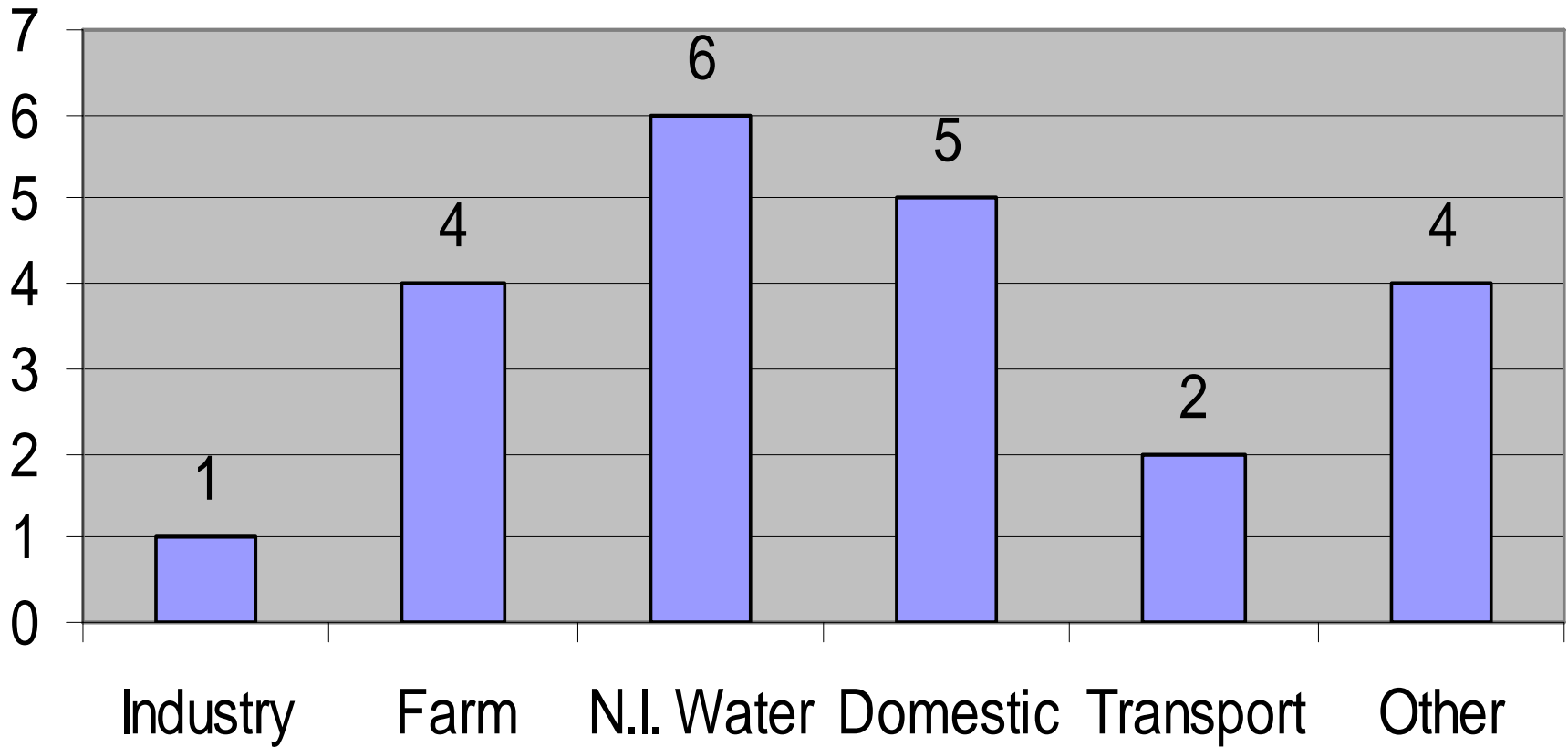

Pollution Incidents

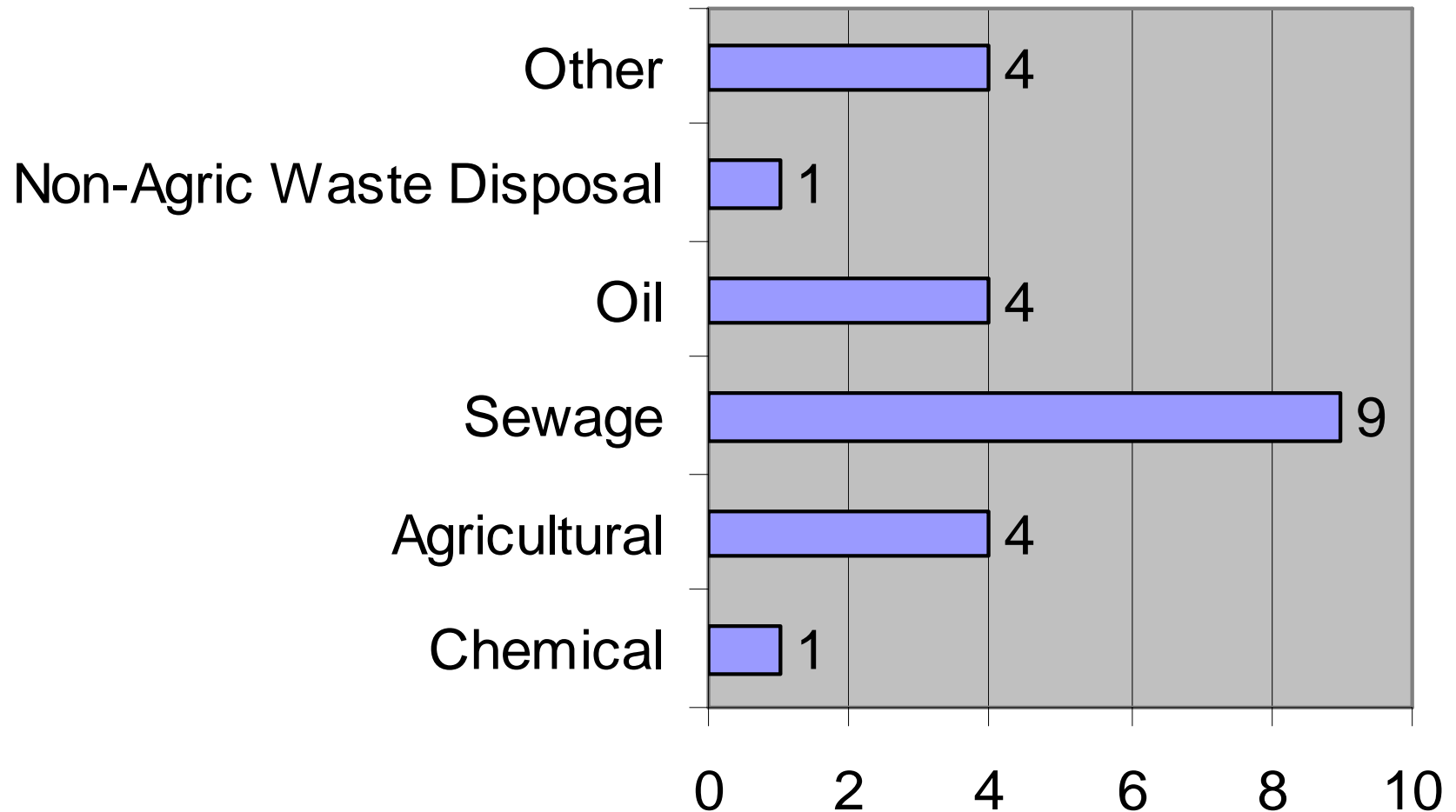
October 2007 to March 2008

- 3 Statutory Samples taken, both with a view to prosecution.
- Prosecution recommended for:-
 - Farm (3 incidents).
