Best practice guidance is given in the recently published DARD Codes of Good Agricultural Practice.

- DF to get an update from NIEA Waste and Contaminated Land colleagues on issue of dairy waste disposal to land.

Application for an authorisation from NIEA and compliance with NAP required.
