**CLOSURE OF PROVISIONAL ENFORCEMENT ORDER CPEO/07/03
MADE UNDER SECTION 30 OF THE WATER AND SEWERAGE
SERVICES (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 2006**

**CPEO/07/03: SEAGAHAN WATER SUPPLY ZONE – TRIHALOMETHANES
CONTRAVENTIONS**

1. Background

- 1.1 CPEO/07/03 was issued to NI Water by the Drinking Water Inspectorate on 08 October 2007 and, subsequently, an agreed set of undertakings were accepted by us on 09 November 2007.
- 1.2 The undertakings provided by NI Water were required in respect of ongoing trihalomethane contraventions in the Seagahan Water Supply Zone identified during the period January 2007 to September 2007.
- 1.3 We have been monitoring progress with these undertakings through the Compliance Programmes' Quarterly Review Meetings.

2. NI Water's Undertakings and Closure of CPEO/07/03

- 2.1 NI Water provided us with a series of undertakings on 09 November 2007. The final work to upgrade Seagahan WTW was completed during 2009 and the works has been in supply from November 2009. The 'taking over certificate' for the upgrade of Seagahan WTW was provided to us by NI Water on the 27/05/2010.
- 2.2 We have assessed the water quality results for trihalomethanes within the water quality zones supplied by Seagahan WTW and are satisfied that from the period November 2009 to August 2010 there have been no contraventions of the trihalomethane standard.
- 2.3 We have also assessed NI Water's implementation of the actions required under these undertakings and are satisfied with the work that has been carried out. **As of the 07 September 2010, CPEO/07/03 will no longer have affect.**


