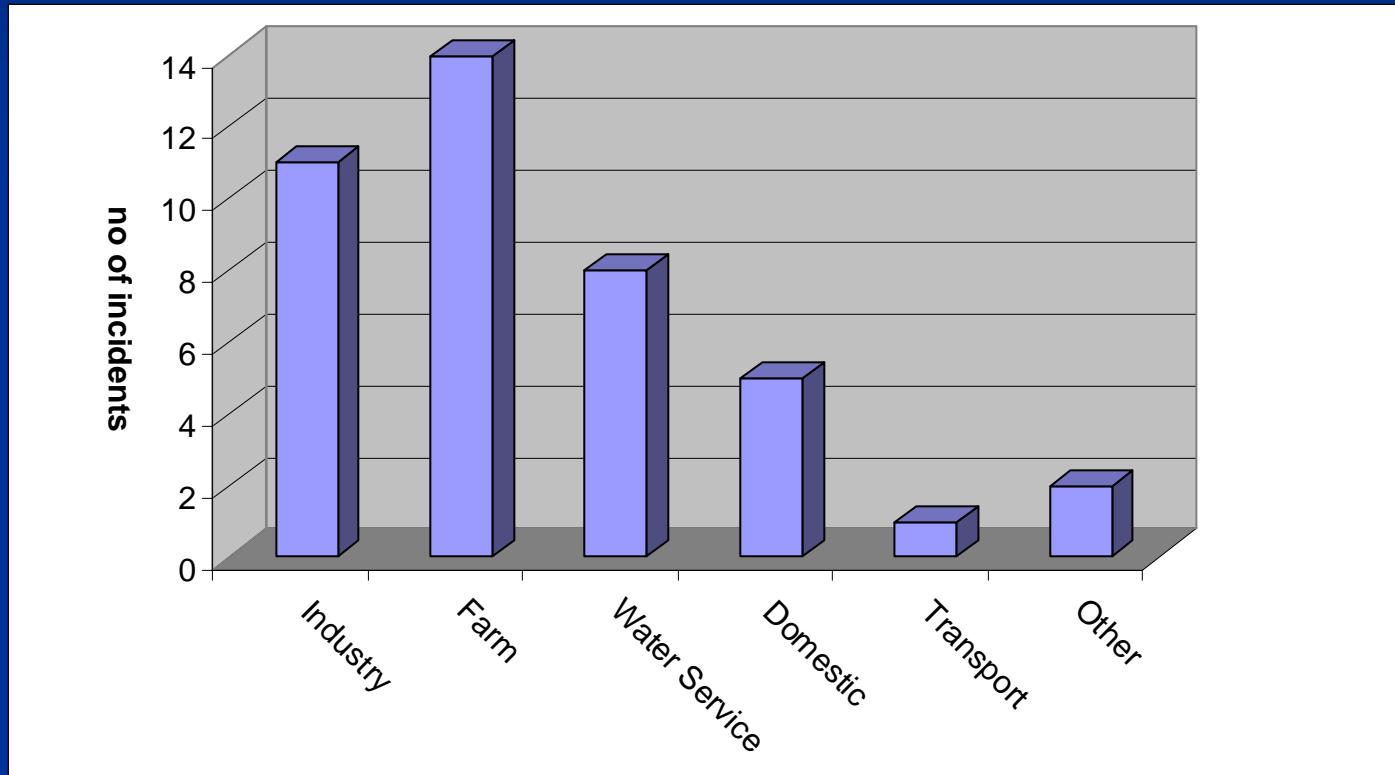

Pollution Incidents Investigated 1st June 2010 to 16th November 2010

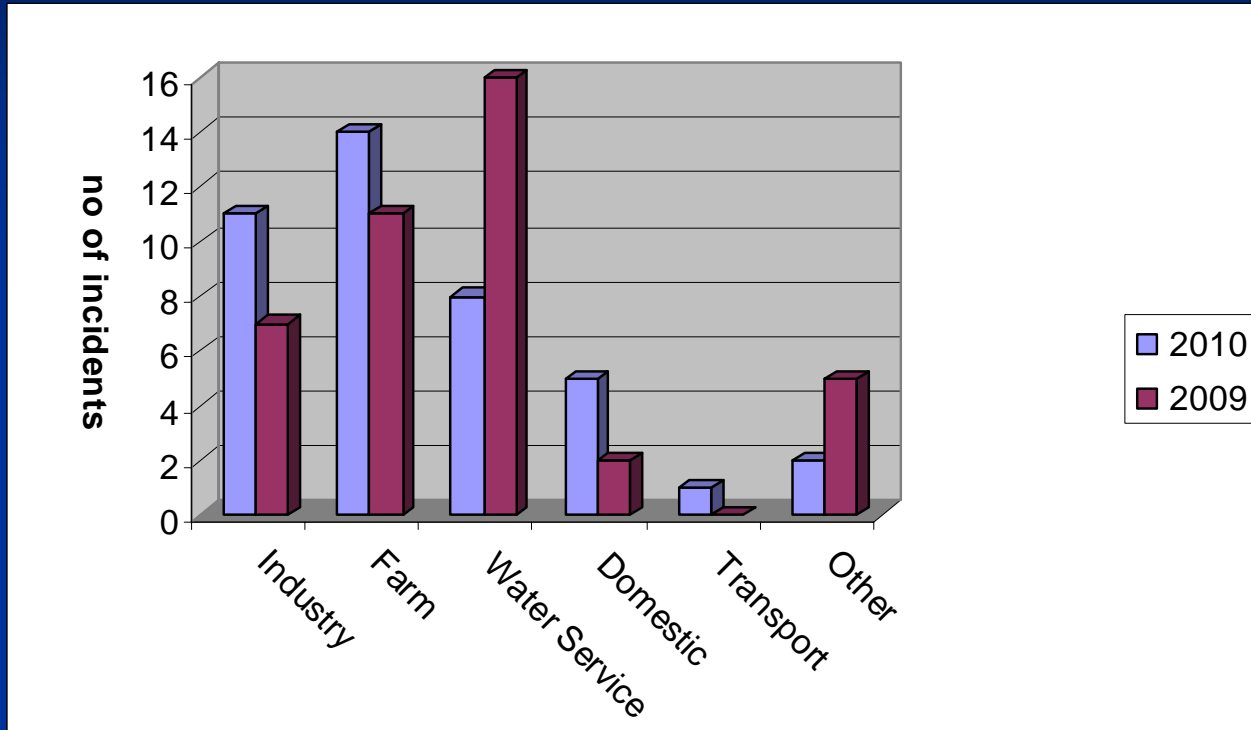
- **66 Investigated** 71 Same period previous year

- **42 confirmed as pollution** 41 Same period previous year
 - **0 High Severity**
 - **7 Medium Severity**
 - **35 Low Severity**

Low severity incidents

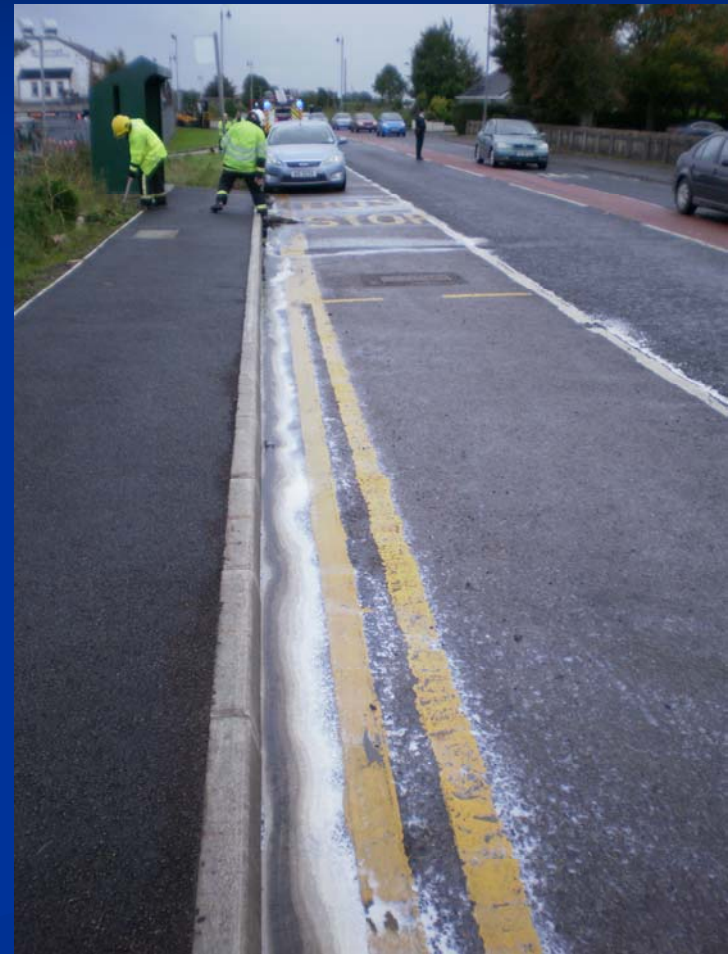


- Oil leaks increased after very cold winter because of fractured pipes

Repatriation of Waste at illegal landfill site



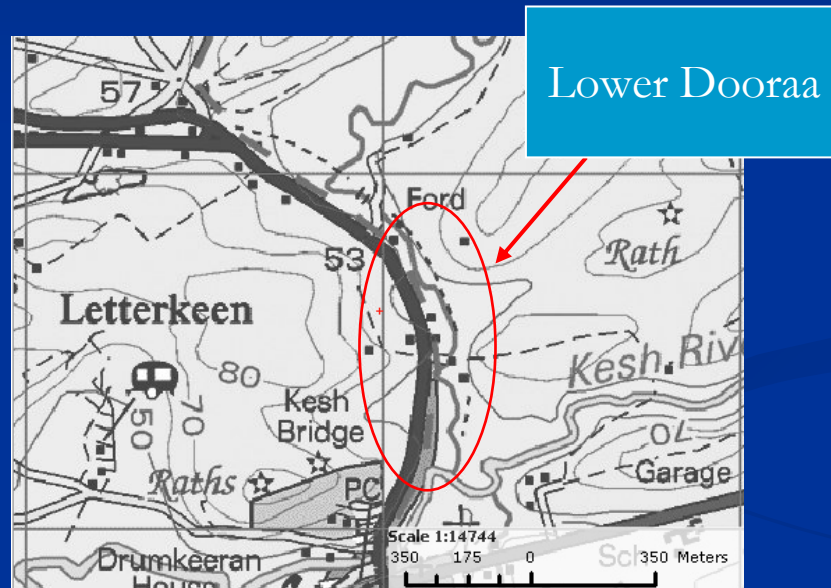
Scheduled Work
