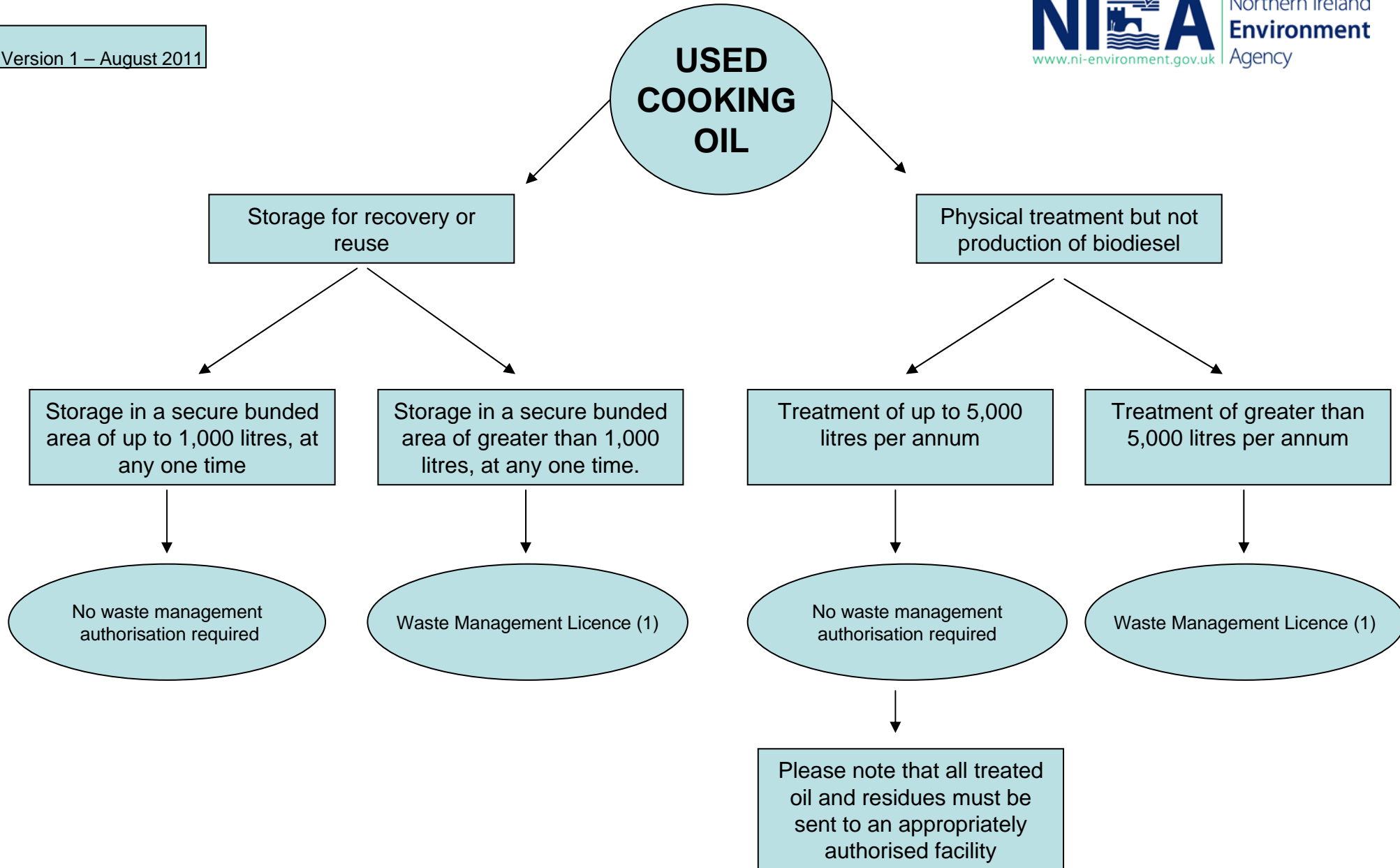
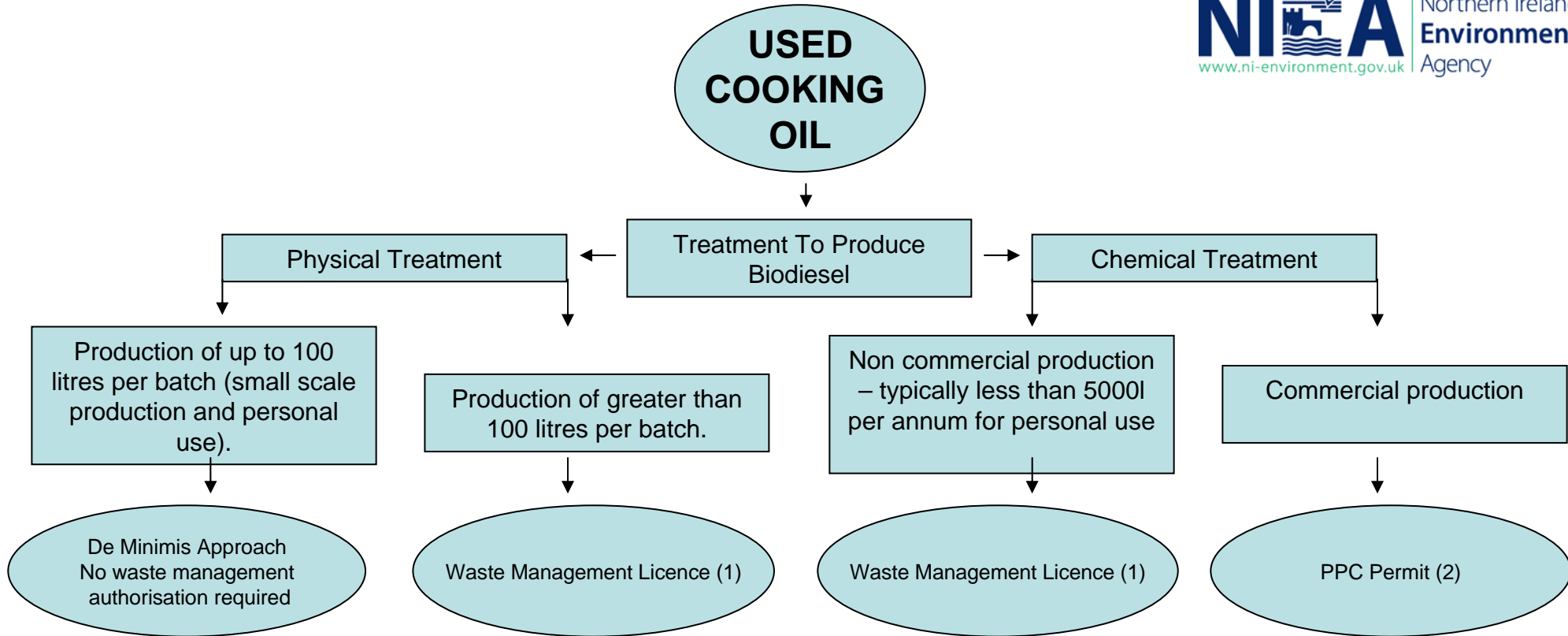

AUTHORISING THE TREATMENT OF USED COOKING OIL TO PRODUCE BIODIESEL



- An operator must initially contact Strategic Planning Division in Planning Service to discuss planning issues Tel: 02890 416700. Appropriate planning permission is a pre-requisite to make a licence or PPC permit application.
- An operator must also contact NIEA Water Management Unit to discuss discharge consent requirements on the site Tel: 02892 623100. A discharge consent or a declaration from NIEA that a discharge consent is not required is a pre-requisite to make a licence application. Discharges will be assessed as part of an PPC Permit application.
- Biodiesel which meets the Biodiesel QP Standard is no longer a waste.
- Biodiesel which does not meet the Biodiesel QP Standard, will still be a waste and must be managed within waste legislation.
