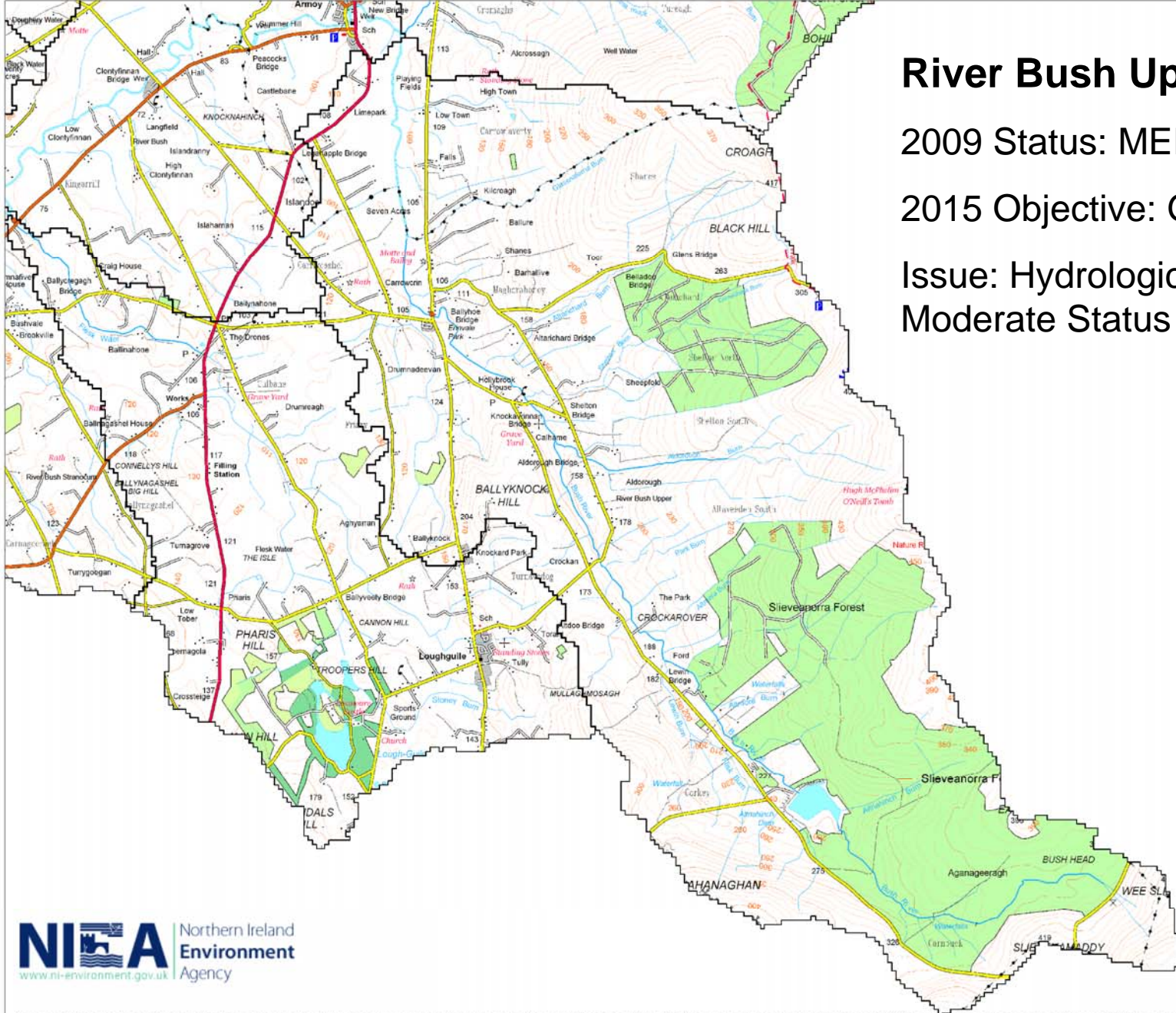


# River Bush Upper

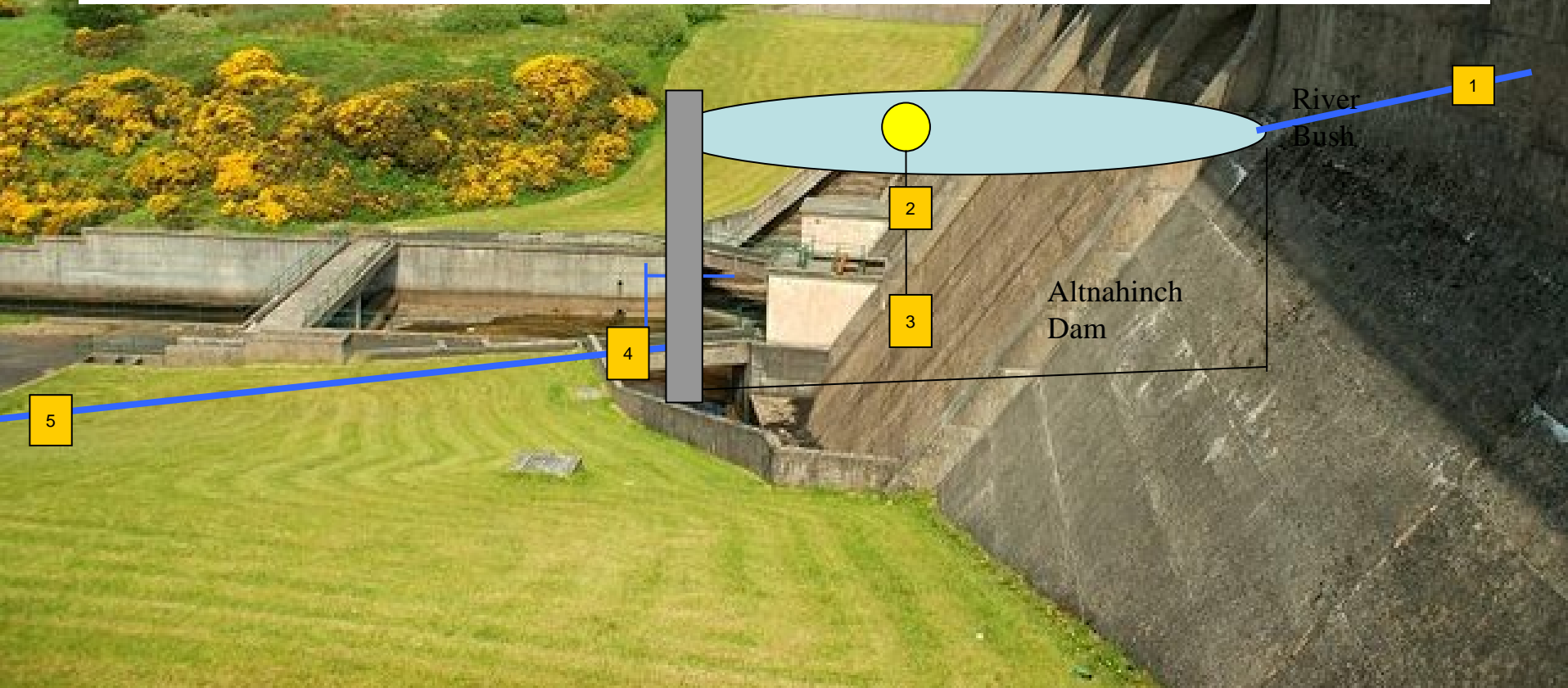
