- ACTION 1
- AMcC to consider invitations to local councillors for future group meetings.
- Invitations to sitting local councillors not deemed appropriate during the election campaign. However, council officials are invited and council is notified of meetings.

- ACTION 2
- AMcC to update group with further detail and information on proposed timeline of the Clean Environment & Neighbourhood Bill.
- Received Royal Assent 4th May 2011
- Consultation process to begin
- Develop guidance and sub-ordinate legislation
- Come into Force April 2012

- ACTION 3
- AMcC to raise issue of river access and riparian development with the Environmental Policy Group and update group at next meeting.
- Local Landscape Policy Areas
- Driven by conservation protection issues
- Does not preclude development
- Conditions could include access to rivers

- ACTION 4
- GS to offer presentation of proposed CSG capital works to the group in spring 2011
