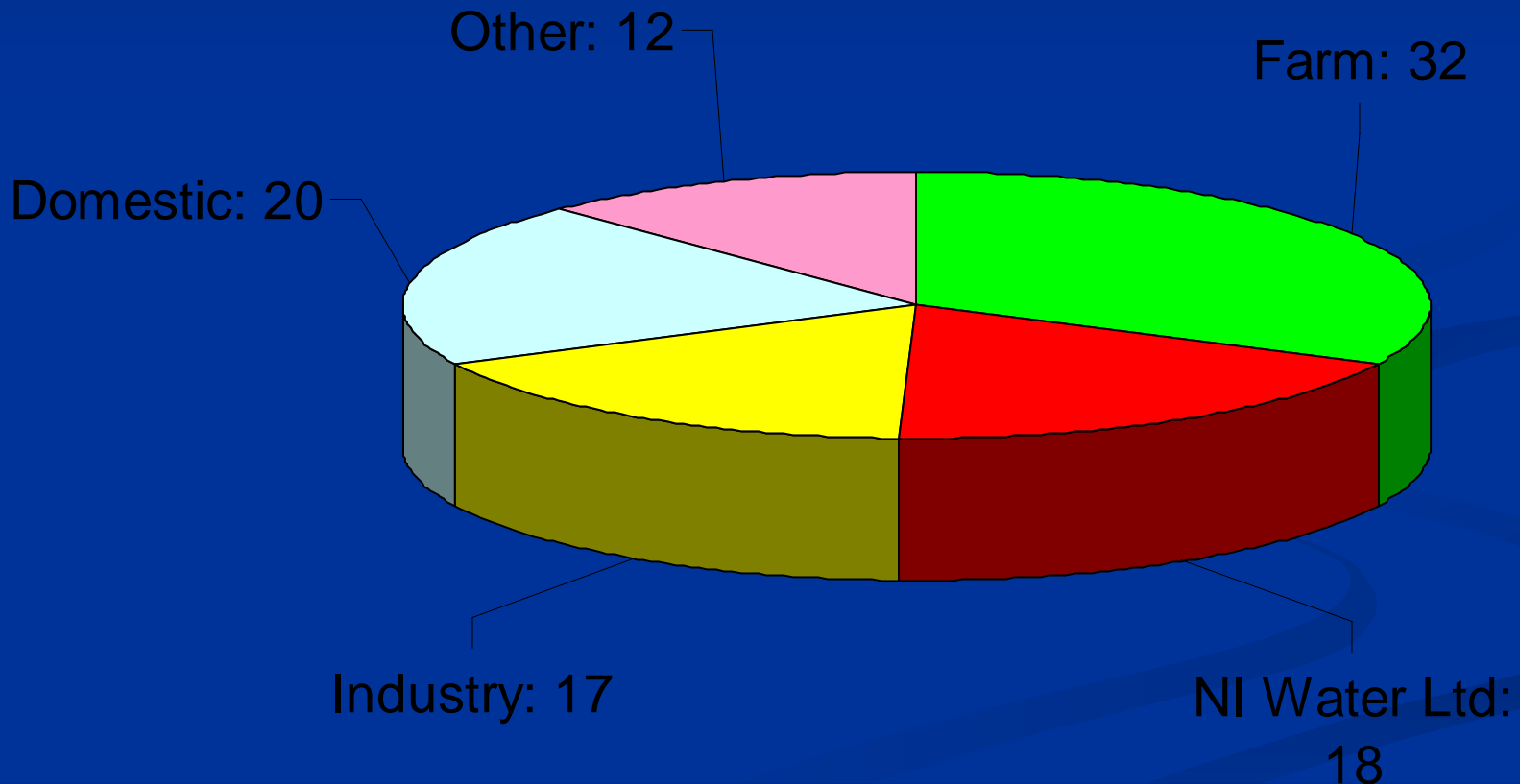
- 137 Incidents Investigated

- 2 Skeoge

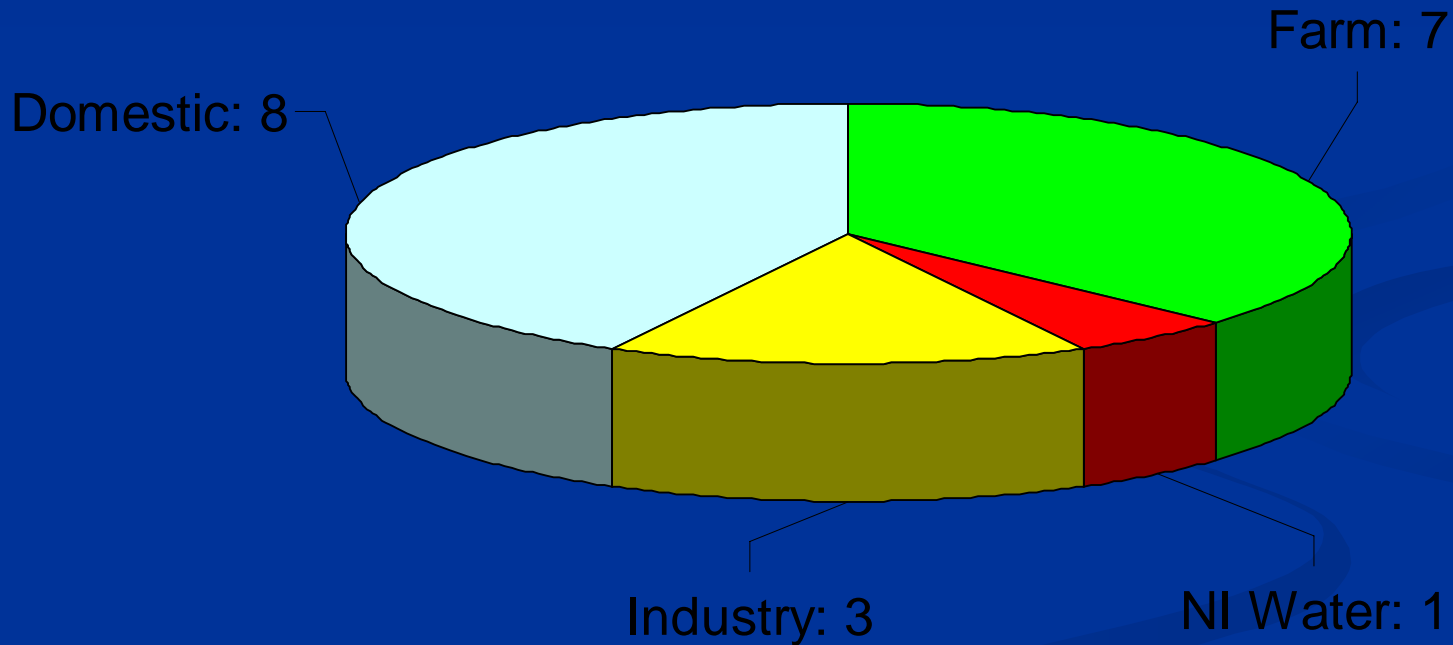
Sources of Pollution
