

Arlene Foster, MLA

Minister of the Environment

Arlene Foster is MLA for Fermanagh and South Tyrone. She was first elected in November 2003 and re-elected in March 2007.

She was appointed Minister of the Environment in May 2007.

By profession she is a lawyer and was in private practice as a Solicitor since 1996.

Prior to her appointment as Minister she was her party's spokesperson for Human Rights, Equality, Children and Young people's issues and was a member of the NI Policing Board from April 2006 – May 2007.

Mrs Foster was a Councillor on Fermanagh District Council representing Enniskillen ward. She resigned in June 2007 as a consequence of being appointed a Minister.
