### SKOOTER SAYS

- 1 **STOP, LOOK** and **LISTEN** before you cross the road
- 2 **STAY** on the footpath or the verge until the bus has moved far away
- 3 Act **SENSIBLY** on and around school buses
- 4 **REMEMBER** traffic can be hidden by the school bus
- 5 **NEVER** cross the road **IN FRONT** of the school bus
- 6 If the bus has **SEATBELTS** **ALWAYS** wear one.
