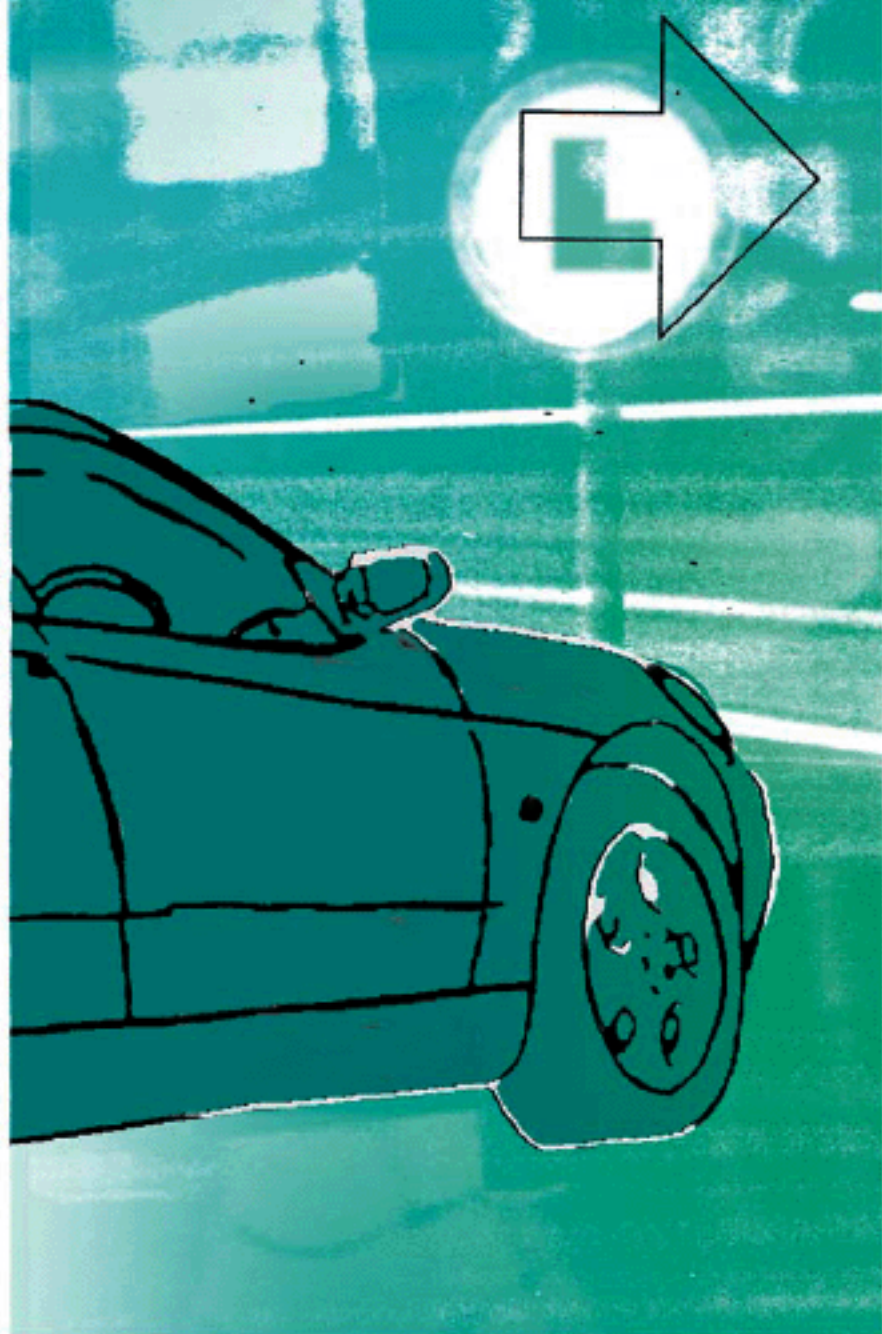

- 17-24 year old drivers are responsible for 34% of all fatal and serious collisions

- excessive speed is the principal factor in 22% of all fatal collisions

- 17-24 year old drivers are responsible for 67% of all speed related deaths

Learn to drive during school hours

Once again this Department is pleased to offer students the opportunity of taking part in our practical driver training course. This course has been designed to provide you with a proper attitude towards driving as well as a higher degree of skill.

Driver Training Course

The course will consist of 12 hours driver training on the road in a modern vehicle with a Department of the Environment Approved Driving Instructor (ADI), 6 hours practical driving and 6 hours as an observer during which time you will learn roadcraft and the theory of driving. The training will be conducted during school hours. You will be taught in groups of 2 per vehicle and applications are accepted only in pairs.



How do you qualify?

Before driving, you **MUST** be 17 years of age and hold a current provisional driving licence. You should choose your own partner, the choice being made on the grounds of timetable compatibility and where possible, similar driving experience.

How much will it cost?

The course is grant aided by this Department which means you will only pay a percentage of the total cost.
